Dear Parishioners of the Diocese of Whitehorse,

RE: Synod on Synodality - The Diocesan Phase

I am pleased to announce to you the Holy Father's initiation of the Synod on Synodality. This Synod was launched with an opening Mass celebrated by Pope Francis on October 7, 2021 and will end in Rome with the Synod of Bishops in October 2023.

Pope Francis has described Synodality as "the way of being the Church today according to the will of God, in a dynamic of discerning and listening together to the voice of the Holy Spirit." He invites all people in every Diocese of the world to pray, reflect and share what the Holy Spirit is telling us today. I, in turn, encourage each one of you to actively participate at the Diocesan synodal phase in whatever capacity you are comfortable with.

The Diocesan phase in our Diocese will begin with an opening Mass on Sunday, November 7, 2021 which will be celebrated at the 10:30am Mass from Sacred Heart Cathedral. It will be recorded, therefore if you are unable to attend, you are welcome to watch it on our Roman Catholic Diocese of Whitehorse Facebook page and YouTube channel.

We have prepared cards for the *Prayer for the Synod: Adsumus Sancte Spiritus* for you to use during this Diocesan synodal phase. It is a simplified version of the prayer which has been historically used at Councils, Synods and other Church gatherings for hundreds of years. We are also developing specific materials based on the Synod Preparatory document and Vademecum to assist with group discussions and individual submissions. This material will soon be available through your local churches and on the Diocese of Whitehorse website. I believe many fruits can come from this Diocesan synodal phase, not only for the Church, but also for our Diocese as we engage with the Synod themes of Communion, Participation and Mission. May God bless you and your families as we move through this process. I remain,
